The Foundation of Madrasah Ibrahim was laid by Mr Ibrahim Khan Raja (Late), a British citizen originally from the village of Tatral, where he was born. In 1999 he envisaged the need to provide religious education to young children in Tatral and the surrounding villages. He started the project to establish a Madrasah in Tatral by building on his family land. Unfortunately in February 2007, before completing the project, Mr Raja passed away. Inna lillahi wa inna ilayhi raji'un (انا لله وانا اليه راجعون). However after Mr Raja's death the family continued and completed the project. The Madrasah was officially opened in 2008, catering the need for the religious education and memorisation of Qur'an for boys aged 5 years old or over. Since opening, the Madrasah has produced 40 Hafidh-al-Qur'an many of whom now provide religious education to other children in the local villages. On 1 January 2012 Mr Raja's family handed over the management of the Madrasah to Mr Raja son in law, Mr Fida Chaudhary, a solicitor of the Supreme Court of England and Wales and owner of Makka solicitors Ltd.

Since Makka Solicitors Ltd became involved in the project, day-to-day running of the project was assigned to Muhammad Nawaz Malik. Thereafter a number of projects were envisaged, completed and are being planned most of which are outlined in details in our Projects & Achievement section of the website.


In March 2014, we opened a primary school, Al-Alim Islamic Public School. We intended to start with a primary school and then increase a class every year and we hope to continue with the same strategy until we reach university level education. In March 2017 we started admission for middle school and the classes will start from April 2017. At present, approximately 200 students are studying at the school. This is in addition to approximately 30 children studying for hifdh at the Madrasah and most of them are full time boarders.

The children studying at the Madrasah also benefit from the school as they attend classes alongside the school students to supplement their religious education and hifdh studies. Similarly the school students attend Madrasah classes to benefit from religious education.

The school is intended not only to provide free education to orphans in the local area, but also to assist them beyond their schooling by providing them with opportunities to earn a living.

The charity has been registered with the Charity Commission in the UK under the name of Chountra Welfare Association UK under the Registration Number 1164619.

Mr Malik was born in the village of Saroba, Thana Chountra. He graduated from Punjab University and Command & Staff College Quetta. He is a director of Islamic Research Academy. He is also the publisher of Tadrees Lughat ul Quran which was written by his late father Professor Abu Masood Hassan Alvi.

After his retirement from the Pakistan Army, Mr Malik wanted to serve the people of his native area and therefore since his retirement, he has been actively involved in improving the lives of many of his native villagers and it is mainly due to his efforts, many welfare projects including the construction of Flood Protection Bund Saroba, completion of Saroba bridge, upgradation of Govt. Girls Middle School to Secondary level and completion of Primary School Buildings for seven shelterless schools were completed.

Based on his outstanding efforts and achievements, in 2011, Mr Fida Chaudhary requested Mr Malik to take charge of the affairs of the Madrassa Ibrahim with a view to expanding the project to providing school level education and other services in the area. The organisation believes that it is only due to Mr Malik and his family's involvement in the project that it has been successful in promptly achieving its' objectives and therefore Mr Malik is considered to be the backbone of the project. May Allah reward him and his family for their wonderful efforts that they have put in for the project. Ameen
